



THE REVELATION OF JESUS CHRIST

First, let us examine the Biblical Calendar found in the first and the last books of the Bible. Genesis 7:11 says,

In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, on the seventeenth day of the second month - on that day all the springs of the great deep burst forth, and the floodgates of the heavens were opened.

And Genesis 8:3-4 says,

The water receded steadily from the earth. At the end of the hundred and fifty days the water had gone down, and on the seventeenth day of the seventh month the ark came to rest on the mountains of Ararat.

Clearly, 5 months equals 150 days. Therefore, 1 month equals 30 days. Therefore, 1 year equals 360 days.

Next, Revelation 12:6 says,

The woman fled into the wilderness to a place prepared for her by God, where she might be taken care of for 1260 days.

And Revelation 12:14 says,

The woman was given the two wings of a great eagle, so that she might fly to the place prepared for her in the wilderness, where she would be taken care of for a time, times and half a time, out of the serpent's reach.

Clearly, 1260 days equals 3.5 years. Therefore, 1 year equals 360 days. To summarize, the Old Testament and the New Testament agree that the Biblical Calendar equals 360 days.

Second, let us examine Daniel's Seventieth Week found in Daniel 9:24-27.

(24) Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins,

and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.

(25) Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.

(26) And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

(27) And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

To summarize, verse 24 says that the prophecy will last 490 years, verse 25 says that the Messiah will arrive after 483 years, verse 26 says that the Messiah will be killed, and verse 27 says that seven years remain. Clearly, the prophecy stops when the Messiah arrives and resumes when the 70th Week starts.

Third, let us examine the Fall of Jericho found in Joshua 6:3-5.

(3) And ye shall compass the city, all ye men of war, and go round about the city once. Thus shalt thou do six days.

(4) And seven priests shall bear before the ark seven trumpets of rams' horns: and the seventh day ye shall compass the city seven times, and the priests shall blow with the trumpets.

(5) And it shall come to pass, that when they make a long blast with the ram's horn, and when ye hear the sound of the trumpet, all the people shall shout with a great shout; and the wall of the city shall fall down flat, and the people shall ascend up every man straight before him.

To summarize, verse 3 says that Israel marched around Jericho once each day for six days, verse 4 says that on the 7th day, they marched around Jericho 7 times, and verse 5 says that on the 7th trip, they blew the trumpets, gave a loud shout, and the walls of Jericho collapsed.

Prophetically speaking, this sevenfold pattern foreshadows the Seven Seals and Seven Trumpets found in the Book of Revelation. In other words, Christ conquers the earth the same way Joshua conquered Jericho. This is confirmed by Matthew 24:31,

He shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

And 1 Thessalonians 4:16,

For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God.

And 1 Corinthians 15:52,

In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

And Revelation 20:6,

Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ and shall reign with him a thousand years.

Clearly, the Last Trump or Seventh Trumpet, accompanied by a loud shout, marks the Return of Christ, the First Resurrection of the Saints, and the Start of the Millennium.

Fourth, combining the Biblical Calendar, Daniel's 70th Week, and the Fall of Jericho reveals that the Seven Seals last 7 years. Therefore, 1 seal is opened every year during the 70th Week.

Fifth, Revelation 8:1-2 says that the Seventh Seal starts the Seven Trumpets. Therefore, 1 trumpet is sounded every 2 months during the 7th Year.

Sixth, Revelation 11:15-19 says that when the Seventh Trumpet sounds, the Temple in Heaven is opened and Revelation 15:5-8 says that when the Temple is opened, the Seven Plagues begin. Therefore, the Seventh Trumpet starts the Seven Plagues.

Seventh, Revelation 13:4-5 says that the Beast will reign for 42 months, but Daniel 12:11 says that the sacrifices are stopped for 43 months. This missing month is best explained by Zechariah 11:8,

In one month I got rid of the three shepherds.

Prophetically speaking, this foreshadows the conquest of the Dragon, the Beast, and the False Prophet which occurs during the Seven Plagues (Revelation 16:12-16). In other words, the Seven Plagues last 1 month. Therefore, 1 plague is poured out every 5 days during the 43rd month. So, although Christ returns on day 1260, the Antichrist is not removed from power until day 1290.

In conclusion, the timeline is confirmed by the Three Woes or 5th, 6th, and 7th Trumpets. Revelation 9:1-5 says that the Fifth Trumpet marks the release of locust that torment mankind for 5 months. According to our timeline, there are 2 months between the Fifth and Sixth Trumpets, 2 months between the Sixth and Seventh Trumpets, and the Seventh Trumpet is the Seven Plagues which last 1 month. In other words, the Three Woes last exactly 5 months. Therefore, the timeline is correct.
